We don't share or sell any information on this form, but you may prefer to leave out a work phone or cell phone. Please note that our newsletter, known as the Foc's'le (check Wikipedia for derivation and pronunciation) can be received by email or regular mail. Should you prefer regular mail, note that there is a \$15 additional fee. If you elect to get an emailed copy, please be sure to enter a valid email address. Should you wish to use your online bill payment, for the fees, please set up a payee account in the name of Hunterdon Sailing Club and use the address at the bottom of page 2 of the form.

For the Youth Learn to Sail program and Junior Sail Team, the Waiver and Health Record must be submitted with the application. Spaces in the Youth Learn to Sail are limited and tend to fill up quickly. All spaces will be allocated on a first come with all documents in order basis. Applications that do not have the Waiver and Health Record will be set aside until the documents come in, or until the classes are filled. No spaces can be held by phone call or email.

Please be aware that I will be travelling until about March 1. I will be able to check the email address below from time to time to answer questions. The phone number below is my cell phone. As applications come in to my home mail box, they will be dated and opened in order when I return.
