NJYRA Juniors & Midgets

On Tuesday, July 10th HSC will be hosting the NJYRA Junior and Midget Championships. Clubs which are members of NJYRA (such as HSC) can send 3 boats for each: 420's or Optimists. The 420 is a 2 person boat, and the Optimist Pram is a 1 person boat. The midgets will be held in the Optimist in accordance with the class rules (sailors must be under 15 and 150 pounds). The Junior Championships will be held in 420's.

Notice of Race: WREN "Wregatta", Sunday, July 15th, 2012

RULES: The Jet-14 "Wren Wregatta" will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Jet Class Association Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY:

- ♦ The "Wren Wregatta" is open to all Jet-14 sailboats.
- ♦ Juniors and Novices are encouraged to participate. Additional trophies will be provided for top junior and top novice.
- ◆ To qualify as a "Junior" boat, both skipper and crew may not turn 20 years old in 2012.
- ♦ To qualify as a "Novice" boat, the skipper may not regularly skipper a Jet 14. Boats where the skipper and crew switch positions will qualify. All sailors are eligible to crew on a "Novice" boat.

REGISTRATION: Official registration for both events will take place at the HSC area in the Spruce Run Recreation Area on the day of the event. Coffee and donuts will be available. Please bring your own lunch.

BOAT STORAGE: Boats may be stored overnight July 14th at Spruce Run for those participating in the regatta.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Sunday, July 15th, 2012

Registration, Coffee and Donuts: 9-10AM Skippers meeting: 10AM

1st Warning signal: 10:30AM, 1 – 3 races Lunch Break: 12 – 1PM on shore

Balance of races with regular HSC races, 1st signal at 1:30PM; No race to start after 4 PM

FEES: \$15 per boat, includes registration, refreshments and trophies.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing Instructions will be available at registration. Courses will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

VENUE: Regatta headquarters: Boat Launch area of the Spruce Run Recreation Area

ALTERNATE PENALTIES: Alternate penalties will be according to RRS 44.2 (720 Rule).

SCORING: The series will be scored as provided in Appendix A of the RRS using the Low Point System. One race constitutes a regatta. There will be no throw-outs.

Flying Scot Fleet # 184 News




The Flying Scot fleet had an eventful month! Here are some of the highlights:


