# **Albacore Fleet Report**

Last year was an outstanding year for the Hunterdon Albacore Fleet. We started our season with a record tumout of sailors from as far afield as Ontario Canada and Florida, who gave us two great days of competition. Most notable of the Hunterdon Fleet's competitors was Tim Spicer of Team Reservoir Dog. Tim, who at twelve, was the youngest Albacore Skipper to compete in any United States Albacore Association event in the past decade. With two additional teams joining us this year; Tish and George Cassa of Team Cassa and, Gennise Schule and Gary Peatick of Team Magic, our level of competition out on the pond went through the roof. With intense but friendly competition, trading off of the lead week after week the skill level of the whole fleet rose to a whole new plain, culminating in the exciting fall series won by a hair by Team Magic.

We certainly hit the road a lot too, attending all of the major Albacore events in the Northeastern US. Cambridge and West River, Maryland, the Potomac River in Washington DC Monmouth Sailing Club and Dewey Beach Delaware. At the US Nationals, North Americans Delaware Governors cup, we represented the club well, scoring generally in the mid fleet against intense, often international competition. Gary Peatick took home third at the Tuna Bowl and the Fleet Captain dragged home the Endurance Award at Nationals. George Cassa performed very well during the North Americans as well.

We, as a fleet, are looking forward to a promising new sailing season. We have teams planning on attending the Mid Winters and the International championships in Torquay England and all the US competions. Our supply of readily available, affordable, tuned and ready to sail Albacores is pretty constant, so we are looking forward to welcoming more fun loving sailors to the Class and Club.


